



VOYAGER ACADEMY is interested in offering students and VA friends the opportunity to complete the NC requirements for obtaining their NC Learners Permit and NC Driver's License.

WHY?

Driver education programs are available statewide to students in their home school district. Many of the local districts have fees between \$45 - \$65 with limited class schedules which are already full with their students to take the class within their home district for the summer.

HOW?

After discussing all the state requirements with the VA Administration, parents and contacting several private driving schools, we are happy to announce a private class for Driver Education at Voyager Academy for the Summer of 2016.

WHO?

Jordan Driving School of the Carolinas operates throughout greater eastern North Carolina with a full-time staff of instructors, offering private and public instruction to NC Eastern Region school districts. This private program for Voyager Academy students and invited friends, will offer 30-hours classroom instruction as well as 6-hours behind-the-wheel instruction by certified instructors, as required by NC DMV.

WHEN?

Taking into consideration the busy summer schedule of everyone, we have narrowed the classroom to two possible weeks. The class will be offered in **4-days**:

Mon/Tues – 830A – 430P and Wed/Thurs – 830A – 330P

DATES: July 18, 19, 20, 21

PRIVATE CLASS FEE:

The normal private student 30-hour class and 6-hour behind the wheel driving fee with JDSC is \$395. The fees for the Voyager Academy class have been discussed and we are happy to announce private fee rates as follows:

FEE RATES:

18 - 20+ - \$325

15 - 17 - \$340

14-Less - \$395

More Important Details:

- Students must be 14-1/2 yrs. of age to take Drivers Education.
- Class will be a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 22 and the above fee rates apply accordingly.
- North Carolina requires all students to have a DMV basic eye check. DMV will send a representative to the class to administer this basic eye check.
- Attendance for the 30-hour class is required. We do understand “life happens” with illness, however, this must be a priority commitment – classroom and driving. The JDSC staff/instructor will work with the student who is sick, with a doctor’s note to make up the time.

Registration:

Registration is required with a deposit of \$200.00 / (\$50/*non-refundable*). The balance of the class fee is due the first day of class. Payments can be made by check (payable: Eddie Jordan) debit/credit – please advise and directions on how to process debit/credit will be forwarded to you.
